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## WEEKEND & LONG TRIP POLICIES

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1. Reservations are on a first come, first served basis. Deposits are required when booking.
2. Cancellations, in writing, may be requested up to the registration deadline. Unless otherwise noted, the full deposit, less a \$10 administration fee, will be refunded.
3. Members may be responsible for full costs after the registration deadline.
4. If a trip is fully booked, members may place their name on a waiting list. The trip leader will contact you if a spot becomes available.
5. Full payment must be received by the payment deadline.
6. Trips are open to CSC members only.
7. Unless otherwise noted, late registrations may be accepted after the deadline provided space is available and full payment is made.

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## Spruce Woods Weekend

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**Friday, January 27 to Sunday, January 29, 2017** (2 nights)

Accommodations: Forest Hills Cabins 13 km south of Carberry on #5 Highway, 15 minutes from park, next door to Sand Hills Casino. Free WiFi, TV, BBQ and Hot Tub and all amenities for cooking.

Cost: \$80 - \$90 per person based on double occupancy per bed. There are 2 Queen beds per cabin, one in the loft and one on the main floor.

Trip Deposit: \$30 (non – refundable)

Registration Deadline: December 15, 2016.

Transportation: Own responsibility (Carpooling is encouraged)

Trip Description: Ski over 80 km of Spruce Woods groomed trails along creeks and rolling topography. Provincial Park Passes are required for vehicles.

Trip Deposit: \$70 (non-refundable)

Registration Deadline: January 18, 2017

Transportation: Chartered bus included in price.

Trip Description: Great skiing on Mackenzie Island. Trails are very

well groomed by the Red Lake Club. The ski trails are a series of loops that allow you to tailor your skiing to your personal fitness level. The trails traverse a variety of habitat from mixed forest to wetlands. Red Lake will also have their Winter Festival this weekend with plenty of activities for après ski.

- Rate 3 – An intermediate skier who is able to ski 10-15 km over flat/hilly terrain with a light to medium pack
- Rate 4 – An experienced skier who is able to ski 15+ km over flat/hilly terrain with a medium pack at a fast pace
- Rate 5 – A skilled and experienced skier who can ski 20+ km in difficult and/or off-trail terrain with a medium pack at a fast pace.
