Rate 3: an intermediate skier who is able to ski 10-15 km over flat/hilly terrain with a light to medium pack.

Rate 4: an experienced skier who is able to ski 15+ km over flat/hilly terrain with a medium pack at a fast pace.

Rate 5: a skilled and experienced skier who can ski 20+ km in difficult and/or off-trail terrain with a medium pack at a fast pace.
